STUDENTS:

- All students Grades K-12
- Includes students who take private lessons, must have teacher approval to enter
- Any student with natural talent (not in art classes)
- By entering artwork, this will be considered an acknowledgment of a media release form

AWARDS:

- Cash Prizes and 1ST, 2ND, AND 3RD place ribbons will be awarded to three categories; categories will be determined based on the art that is entered. There will be three age groups (elementary, middle, high school).

REQUIREMENTS:

- No more than 3-5 pieces per student unless approved by CTAC; we will select if space becomes an issue
- Required – must be hang-ready for our art hanging system & hooks
 - If art is framed, it has to be **wired to hang** (no saw tooth hangers)
 - Art can be matted on foam poster board, etc. (we will use clamps on matted pieces)
- Display ready (sturdy, for table displays)
- Properly labeled on the back
 - Student Name
 - School Name, Grade, Teacher/ Parent Name
 - Contact Information (phone/ email)
- CTAC **reserves the right to not display** any piece based on content or the limitations of space in the gallery.

EXHIBIT LENGTH:

- All artwork will hang in the gallery March 1 – 24 (must remain hanging)
- Artwork must be picked up March 25, 28, or 29th (9:30 - 4:00)
- Please call ahead for special arrangements 580-252-4160
