

The Chisholm Trail Arts Council Visual and Performing Art Scholarship

This scholarship is provided through CTAC, a nonprofit 501 (c)(3) organization, from funds secured through memberships, donations and/or contributions from local businesses to assist student(s) in obtaining their education goals with a degree in visual and performing arts. The recipient(s) of this scholarship will receive a \$500 cash award to be used at an eligible postsecondary arts program, two-year college, or four-year university within the United States.

General Scholarship Information:

- This scholarship is a one-time award worth \$500. It is paid towards the fall semester and must be used towards tuition or books. There will be 2-\$500 scholarships awarded in the spring.
- Deadline has been extended to April 22, 2022. <u>ALL material must be</u> <u>received no later than deadline.</u> Mail completed application and required support material to:

- The scholarship is open to high school seniors (first-time freshman college applicant only) with at least a 3.0 high school grade point average.
- Applicants must reside and attend school within Stephens County, Oklahoma.
- Recipients must enroll full-time at an accredited, eligible postsecondary art program, two-year College, or four-year University within the United States with ART as a major or a minor.
- Applicants must submit 3 samples of original artwork/ theater performances via email (JPEG, video – flash drive) along with teacher's reference.
- Preference will be given to students with a strong visual/ performing arts history, teacher references, strong leadership, and leadership background.
- Recipients agree to allow CTAC to use photos, likenesses and name for publicity purposes.
- The CTAC Arts Education in Schools (AES) scholarship committee will meet in April/May. Applicants will be notified by mail about the status of their application. The scholarship will be disbursed in this manner: a check will be sent to the school upon receipt of enrollment/ registration of classes.
