B.C. Gilbert was born and raised in Amarillo, TX. He received a BFA in painting in 1997 from Cameron University in Lawton, OK and an MFA in painting and sculpture in 2001 from Texas Tech University in Lubbock, TX.

In 2008, he started his teaching career for the Wichita Falls Independent School District where he taught Art I-IV for ten years at the secondary level before switching to teaching welding technology.

B.C. is also a mixed media painter and printmaker, regularly exhibiting his work in solo, juried, and group exhibitions as well as putting together the occasional public art proposal or curating a show when asked.
